

WHA6.18 Study on Campaign against Smallpox

The Sixth World Health Assembly,

Having considered resolution EB11.R58 of the eleventh session of the Executive Board concerning a campaign against smallpox ;

In view of the many economic, social and other technical factors that must be considered,

REQUESTS the Executive Board :

- (1) to proceed with a detailed study of the means of implementing such a campaign, this study to include, inter alia, consultation with Member States and with WHO regional committees, and
- (2) to report to the Seventh World Health Assembly.
